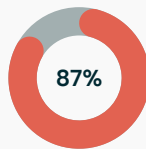
53 staff from three schools completed the survey (for a 79% response rate):

- Proctor HS: 22

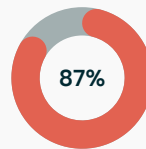

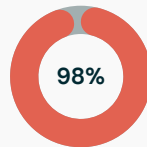
